We recognize that salvation only comes to a child through that child's own trust in Christ as Savior and Lord. It is not passed on to a child through dedication. Through the act of dedication, however, parents covenant to raise their children by modeling Godly principles with the desire that one day, their children will become followers of Jesus themselves. It is also the covenant act of entrusting that child into the community of the church.

We count it a privilege to join with you in dedicating your children to the Lord and covenant with you to do all we can as a faith community to encourage your child's spiritual formation in Christ.
